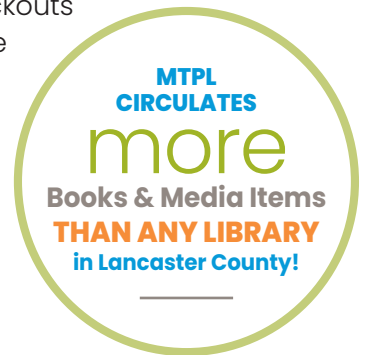




Dear Library Friend,

You may have heard that Manheim Township Public Library (MTPL) is the busiest library in Lancaster County. What does that mean? In 2023 our checkouts are on track to exceed 600,000 and we circulated 66,100 items in the month of June alone.
